DAY 1: Arrival to Baltra & Santa Cruz Island

As you traverse the trails, witness the striking views of Darwin Volcano and Darwin Lake, surrounded by the arid volcanic terrain. Keep an eye out for the diverse birdlife that inhabits the area, including the iconic Galapagos penguins and flightless cormorants. The morning at Tagus Cove promises a contemplative journey through the island's geological wonders and a glimpse into its storied past. Later in the afternoon, venture to Urbina Bay, located on the western side of Isabela Island. This secluded bay is recognized for its uplifted coral formations and the unique opportunity to encounter the Galapagos land iguanas in their natural habitat. Take a leisurely stroll along the shoreline, marveling at the remains of coral structures uplifted during a historic volcanic event. The bay also presents an ideal setting for snorkeling, allowing you to explore the underwater realm teeming with marine life. The afternoon at Urbina Bay offers a serene exploration of Isabela's distinct landscapes and the chance to observe the island's fascinating terrestrial and marine inhabitants.
